The 2023 IPWEA Asset Management Study Tour will be in association with the IPWEA International Asset Management Congress to be held on the Gold Coast, Queensland, Australia, from 14-15 June 2023. Past IPWEA Australasia CEO and current International Advisor Chris Champion will be the tour host.

Study Theme: CASE STUDIES IN INFRASTRUCTURE ASSET MANAGEMENT

The Tour will explore case studies in infrastructure asset management in Councils and will include a mix of international and national delegates. This adds another dimension to the Tour as it provides the opportunity for networking between the delegates from different countries. Limited places will be available on the Tour.

Congress Study Tour

The congress study tour comprises a series of Council-hosted presentations on infrastructure asset management issues.

The host municipalities for the study tour visits include:

Pre-Congress (12-13 June)

- Gold Coast City Council
- Logan City Council
- Brisbane Council

Post-Congress (16 June) Optional

- Tweed Shire Council, including a presentation from neighbouring
- Kvoale Council

Concerning transport, delegates will make their way from their respective hotels to the Gold Coast Convention and Entertainment Centre and travel by bus or train daily to the Councils.

The study tour topics planned to be covered during the visits are:

- Long-term financial planning
- Asset Management Governance
- Asset Management systems
- Integrating the impacts of climate change and disaster management in infrastructure planning

IPWEA International Asset Management Congress

The IPWEA International Asset Management Congress (IIAMC) will be held **on 14-15 June** at the Gold Coast Convention and Entertainment Centre. With two concurrent streams over the two days, the Congress will showcase world-class and innovative Asset Management practices. This premier event is a world-leading opportunity to meet and learn from global





experts and sector leaders and to share experiences with peers. The Congress will generate meaningful discussion and leadership outcomes for the future of infrastructure Asset Management.

Study Tour Costs

The delegate cost for the pre-Congress study tour is \$1,100, including GST, plus Congress registration.

Study Tour participants from within Australia are eligible for the Congress registration member early bird rate irrespective of when they commit to the Tour. In addition, a special congress registration rate is available for international delegates. The study tour price includes the following:

- All lunches and teas on each of the study tour days
- Daily bus or train travel
- Dinner on Monday 12 June and drinks on Tuesday 13 June
- · Tour planning and organisation, and tour guide

Exclusions are:

- Travel insurance (compulsory),
- Airport transfers,
- Accommodation
- Personal expenses and optional sightseeing.

The Tour commences at the Gold Coast Convention and Entertainment Centre on **Monday, 12 June, at 8.30am** (tour group to meet in the Convention Centre foyer) and concludes when delegates are returned to the Convention Centre on 13 June.

An optional 3rd-day post-Congress study tour is available at \$330, including GST.
